Leadership for Africa (LfA)

Who can apply?

- Highly qualified refugees in selected East African countries (Ethiopia, Tanzania, Uganda, Somalia, South Sudan) who hold refugee status and fulfil the qualifications for Master's studies in Germany.
- Highly qualified academics from the selected countries.

Objective

 Leadership for Africa offers scholarships for Masterprogrammes at German universities in all fields of study with the exception of medicine, veterinary medicine, dentistry, law, the arts and architecture.
Public health is open for application

What can be funded?

 Scholarship to complete a M.A. or M.Sc. degree in Germany and an accompanying side study programme (mandatory) in good governance, civil society and sustainable project management.

Duration of funding

• The duration of funding is determined by the period of study of the chosen program. In general, Master's programs require two years of full-time study.

Value

- Monthly scholarship rate payments of 934 EURO
- Adequate health, accident and private/personal liability insurance in Germany.
- Travel allowance.
- One-off study allowance.
- If applicable, family allowance and monthly rent subsidy.
- Language course (2, 4 or 6 months) in Germany before the start of the study programme
- Accompanying study programme
